We are committed to operating responsibly and caring for this place — and we invite our guests to join us by making a few simple, respectful choices during their visit.

Reduce Waste & Single-Use Plastics

We work to minimise waste onboard our vessels and on the island.

You can help by:

- Bringing a reusable water bottle
- Avoiding single-use plastics where possible
- Taking any rubbish with you and disposing of it responsibly

Keeping waste out of the ocean and off the island helps protect marine life and beaches.

Protect Marine Life & Reef Systems

The reef and surrounding waters are living ecosystems that are easily damaged.

You can help by:

- Avoiding touching coral or marine life
- Keeping a respectful distance from wildlife
- Entering and exiting the water carefully
- Following crew guidance while snorkelling

Observing marine life responsibly helps ensure it remains healthy for future visitors.

Use Reef-Safe Products

Some everyday products can harm coral and water quality.

You can help by:

- Using reef-safe sunscreen
- Avoiding chemical sprays near the water
- Rinsing off excess sunscreen before swimming where possible

These small actions can make a big difference to reef health.

Follow Crew Guidance & Safety Briefings

Our crew are trained to operate safely and responsibly in marine environments.

You can help by:

- Listening to safety and environmental briefings
- Following instructions during activities
- Asking questions if you are unsure

This helps ensure a safe and enjoyable experience for everyone.

Respect Culture & Country

Great Keppel Island (Woppa) is the traditional land and sea Country of the Woppaburra People.

You can help by:

- Respecting culturally significant sites
- Staying on designated paths where applicable
- Treating the island, beaches, and surrounds with care

Respecting Country is an important part of caring for this place.
